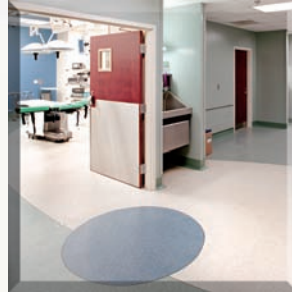

RECOMMENDED MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

General Purpose Applications - Hallways, Aisles, Entryways

Daily Use

- Stonkleen DG2- Green General Purpose Cleaner removes oily, greasy soils found on the floors in education, healthcare, and manufacturing facilities.
- Stonkleen MG2- General Descaler removes hard water mineral deposits found on floors in education, healthcare and manufacturing facilities.

Weekly Use

- Stonkleen SG2- Chlorinated cleaner disinfectant. Use on education, healthcare and manufacturing surfaces that can be cleaned with detergent and water.

Specialty Products to Tackle Cleaning Problems in Food Service, Manufacturing, Healthcare Environments and Public Spaces

Food Service Areas

- Stonkleen FS9- Degreaser removes a wide variety of food fats and oils found in food service, processing, food manufacturing and related restroom facility floors.
- Stonkleen MD9- Removes hard water mineral deposits found on the floors of food service, food processing and food manufacturing facilities.

Manufacturing Areas

- Stonkleen TD9- Removes tire marks found on manufacturing floors. It is also an effective heavy-duty degreaser/cleaner of petroleum oils and metal oxides.

Healthcare Areas

- Stonkleen SR9- Removes grease, food, betadine and other stains found in healthcare facilities.
- Stonkleen DS9- Dissolves and removes acrylic and phenol deposits found on floors in healthcare facilities.

GENERAL FLOOR CLEANING PROCEDURES

Use the instructions and guide below to get the maximum results from your products. Detailed instructions can be found on individual packages.

Hallways, Entryways, Aisles and Rooms

Wet mopping is used for lightly soiled floors. You must wet mop repeatedly to achieve best results.

- Wash new mop heads before using.
- Use all required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) before handling any chemicals.
- Prepare solution by filling a bucket with ½ cold water. Add product according to appropriate dilution ratios (see packaging instructions).
- Dust Mop the area first to remove large particles or debris.
- Remove gum using a putty knife to carefully scrape off the floor without scratching the surface.

Wet Mopping

- Saturate the floor with the cleaning solution, but DO NOT FLOOD.
- Allow the solution to cover the floor for 3-5 minutes.
- Change the water frequently when removing large amounts of dirt.

Rooms

Begin left of the entrance, mopping halfway around the perimeter of the room. Rinse, mop and repeat this step for the right side of the room. Mop the center of the room using an “S” stroke technique.

Hallways

Mop half the corridor at a time allowing access through the area while cleaning. Begin by running the mop 50 ft. away from the bucket along the baseboard. Walking backward and using the “S” stroke technique, return to the bucket. Rinse the mop and repeat on other side of hallway.

*Do not splash baseboards with cleaning solution

- Damp Mop all areas that were not wet mopped with clean water.
- Wipe baseboards using a clean cloth and wipe any soiled areas.

Automatic Scrubber Procedures

- Use all proper PPE
- Prepare solution by filling the tank of the scrubber with cool water. Add the cleaning solution at the appropriate dilution ratios (see packaging instructions).
- Scrubbing light to medium soiled floors using a red scrubbing pad and make one pass over the area with the automatic scrubber.

Heavily Soiled/Damaged Floors

- Use a blue or green scrubbing pad and make two passes with the scrubber. Take note of the dilution ratio (for cleaning heavy accumulations). Refer to individual product data/label for specific ratios.
- Rinse/Trail Mop. Be sure to change the water frequently so no residue remains.

Note: When cleaning textured floors such as Stonshield HRI or Stonshield SLT, brushes should be used instead of the pads. For smoother finished floors such as Stonblend RTZ or Stonlux, the pads should be used.

Heavy Soil Spot Removal

1. Use Stonkleen MD9, TD9 or SR9 at full strength.
2. Pour a small amount of diluted Stonkleen product onto the spot and scrub it in with a medium bristle, nylon scrub brush.
3. Tough build-ups may require 3-5 minute saturation period before rinsing with warm water.
4. Remove water with a squeegee or a wet/dry vacuum.
